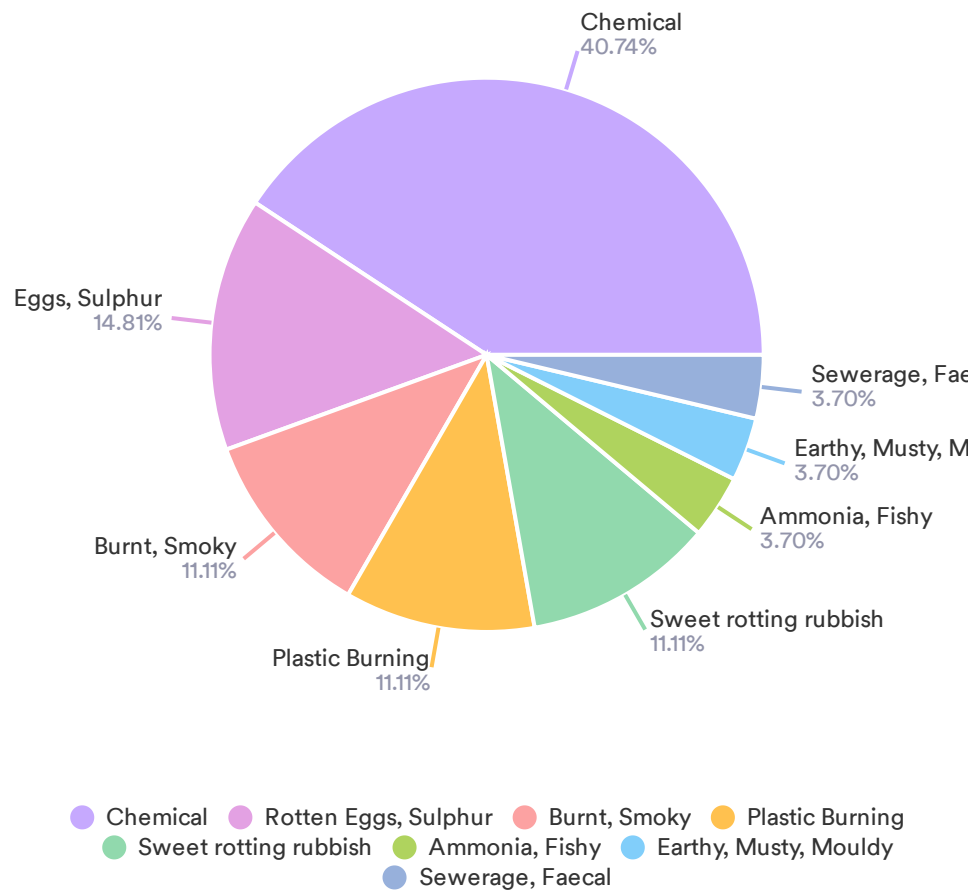

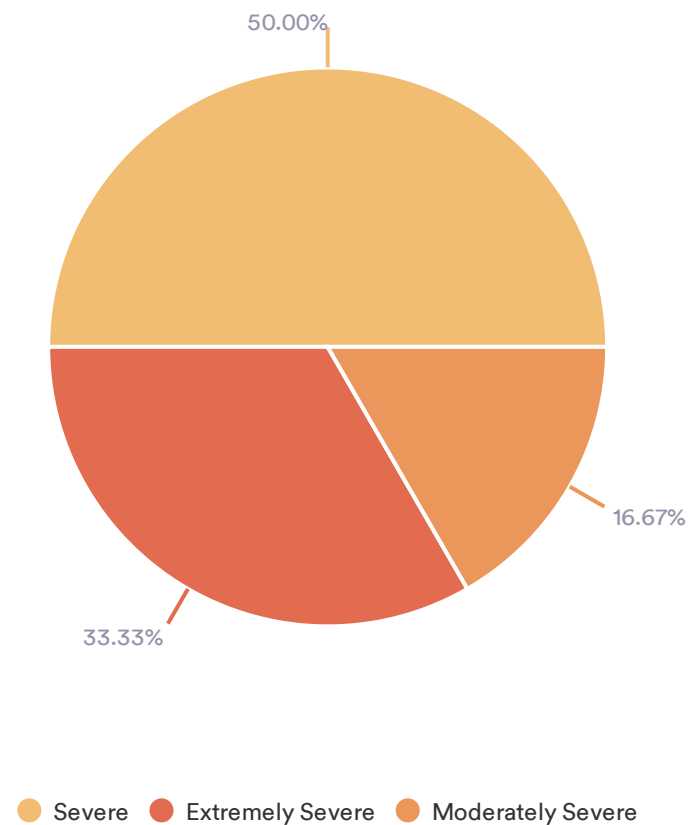

Description of nuisance odours reported.

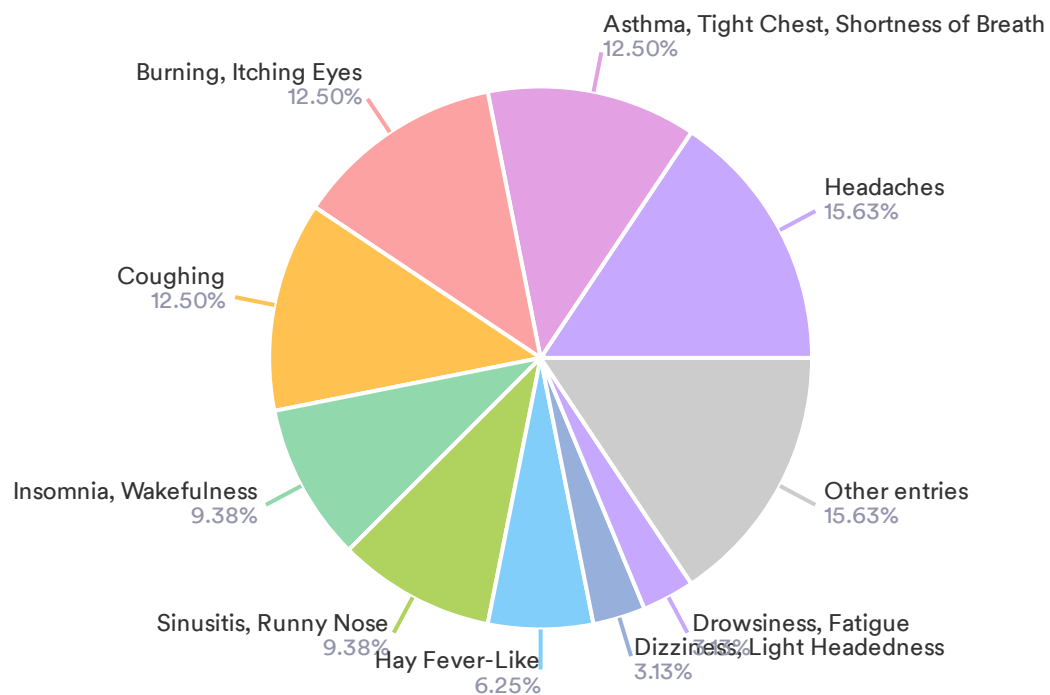


Impact the nuisance odour is having on physical health.

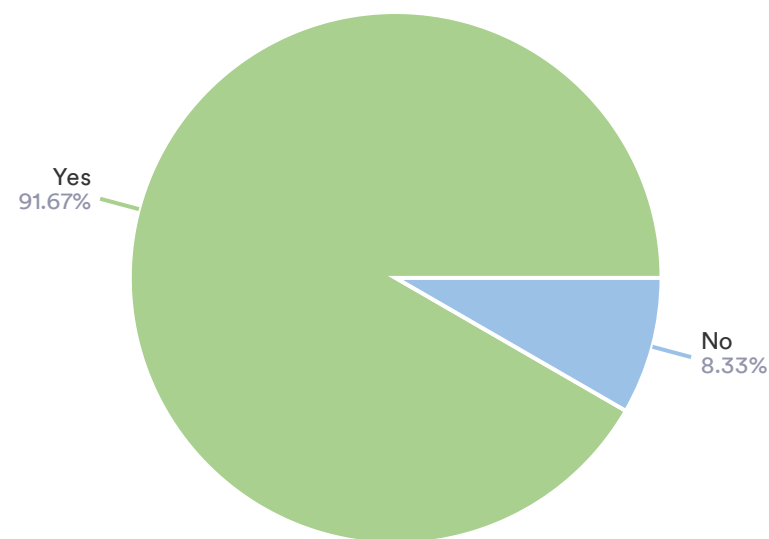
