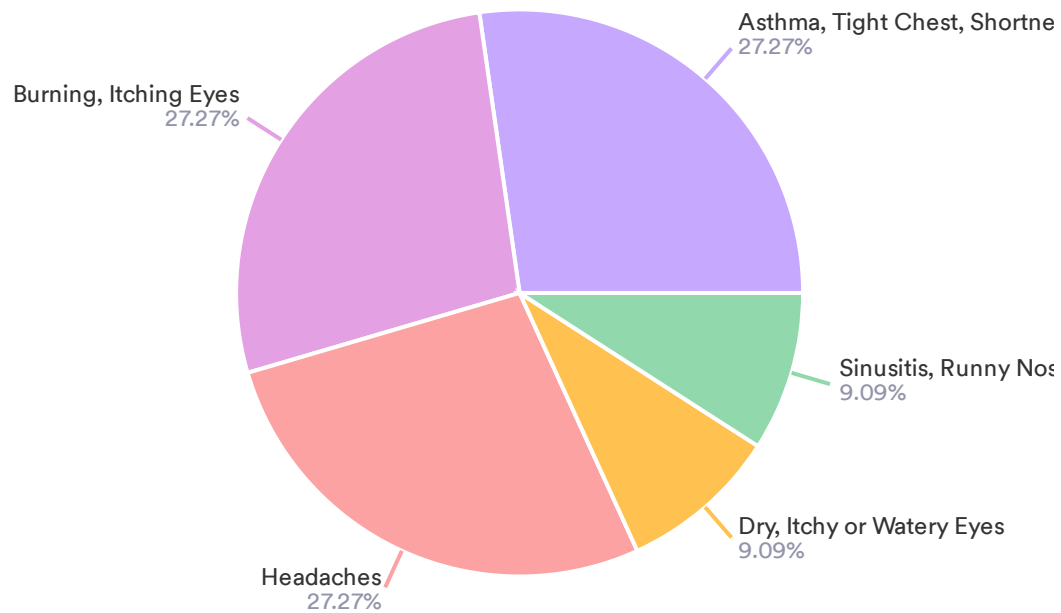

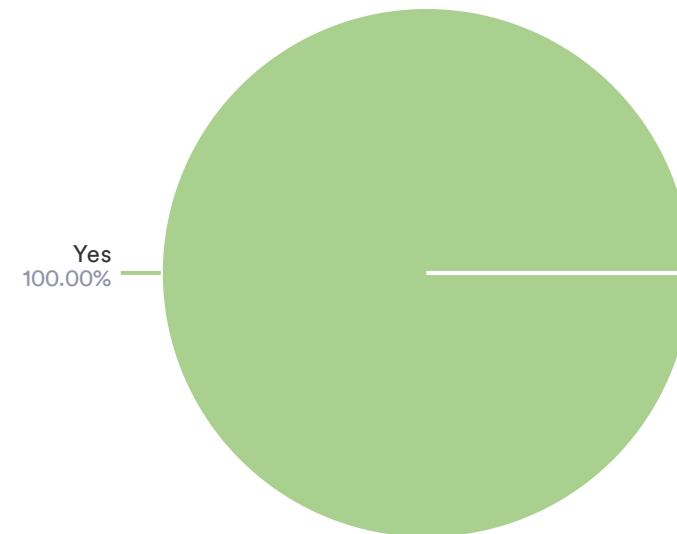

Sep 2024 - PM_{2.5} Air Pollution

SA Legislated PM_{2.5} Standards

24-hour average exposures should not exceed 40 µg/m³ for more than 4 days per year.

Cumulative count Mar 24 to Feb 25

16 days (4 x SA Standard)

Exceedances in Oct

WHO PM_{2.5} Guidelines

24-hour average exposures should not exceed 15 µg/m³ for more than 3 - 4 days per year.

Cumulative count Mar 24 to Feb 25

96 days (24 x WHO Standard)
